

MINKS TO SINKS DONATION GUIDELINES



Thank you for donating and consigning to Minks to Sinks! All proceeds from the sale benefit Family & Children's Agency and help neighbors right here in our community.

For safety, health, and practicality reasons, there are some items we cannot accept. Please read these guidelines for more information.

DONATION GUIDELINES

All donations must be in working condition with no missing parts, and free from stains, tears, and rust.

Items too heavy for two volunteers to carry cannot be accepted.



APPLIANCES: We are happy to accept mini-fridges and dorm fridges as well as stand-alone microwaves. We cannot take air conditioners, cooktops, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, dryers, freezers, humidifiers, built-in microwaves, ovens, full-size refrigerators, stoves, vaporizers, or washers.



AUTOMOTIVE: We do not accept floor mats, hub caps, or tires.



BABY/CHILDREN: We do not accept bassinets, bath toys & books, used infant bathtubs, bibs, booster seats, bouncy seats, car seats, large monogrammed Pottery Barn chairs, changing tables, cribs/pack & plays/playpens, crib bumpers, diaper pails, vintage dollhouses, metal spring ride-on toys, pacifiers, placemats, potty seats/toilets, stuffed toys, teething, train tables, walkers, or painted wood toys (unless organic or Melissa and Doug). **Recalled items not accepted.**



BEDS: We do not accept box springs, bunk beds, futons, mattresses, platform beds, sofa beds, single twin headboards, or metal bed frames without headboards.



BUILDING MATERIALS: We do not take any building materials including cabinets, counters, doors, permanently attached fireplace screens, roof shingles, floor tiles, toilets, vanities, or windows.



CLOTHING/SHOES: We accept all lightly used, clean clothing and shoes. Underwear is only accepted in original packaging.



COMPUTERS/ELECTRONICS: No desktop computers, printers, fax machines, or scanners. We gladly accept working video games and consoles, DVD players, CD players, and VHS players.



CRAFTS: We accept fabric and yarn.



CURTAINS: Fabric curtains are welcome, but no drapery, cornices, valences, rods, window blinds, or roll-up shades.



EXERCISE EQUIPMENT: No heavy weights, stationary bikes, rowing machines, treadmills, or large exercise equipment.



GAS APPLIANCES: Due to safety concerns we do not accept any gas grills, kerosene heaters, or propane tanks. All lawn equipment must be drained of gas, no large ride on equipment accepted.



FURNITURE: We are glad to accept gently used furniture but cannot accept pressboard furniture, armoires, glass cabinets/hutches, entertainment centers, large stereo consoles, or rugs larger than 6x9. We do take love seats or smaller size sofas but no large sofas or sleeper sofas.



GAME TABLES: Due to space constraints we do not accept ping pong tables, pool tables, air hockey tables, train tables, or foosball tables.



HOME HEALTH EQUIPMENT: Due to safety concerns, we cannot accept crutches, shower chairs, walkers, or other home health equipment.



LIGHTING: We accept working lights except chandeliers larger than 2'x2', ceiling fans, halogen lamps, or oversized lights. We accept new light bulbs in original box.



MEDIA: We accept records but do not accept cassette tapes, CDs, DVDs, or VHS tapes. No books - please drop them off at the library.



OFFICE FURNITURE/SUPPLIES: No oversized desks, metal desks, or metal file cabinets. No office supplies accepted.



SPORTS: We are happy to accept sports equipment but cannot take bowling balls, skis, ski boots, snowboards, snowboard boots, or any protective gear including all helmets, pads, gloves, or pants.



SUITCASES: We accept updated suitcases in good condition, but no suit/garment bags or heavy hard-sided suitcases.



TELEVISIONS: We only accept LCD or plasma flat screen televisions with the remote.



ITEMS CLASSIFIED AS HAZARDOUS WASTE FOR DISPOSAL
